Scholarship opportunity. Also unique to Little Eden is that in addition to the paycheck, meals and housing our onsite summer staff receive, they are also eligible for a scholarship for their schooling or school loans. Those staying through Farmer's Week receive a scholarship matching their gross pay at 100% and those staying through R & R 1 or later receive an extra 25% bonus scholarship above the 100% match. Matching 50% scholarships are available to those staying more than five weeks but less than the whole summer. This incredible program has been available to our summer team because of the generosity of campers.

Youth Camps: Consider giving a week or two of your time!

Want to volunteer or work at camp but don't have a whole summer to give?

We are looking for individuals available some or all of **June 9 - 24** to help with our youth camp programs. Here are some **one- or two-week opportunities** to consider:

- Cabin Leaders. Come be a cabin leader for one or two weeks and experience the
 joy of being an instrumental part of positively and spiritually impacting the lives of
 vouth!
- **Certified Lifeguard.** With one or two other individuals, watch over our campers on the waterfront, using boats, or swimming at Lake Michigan.
- Maintenance/Landscape/Flowers. Our maintenance and grounds team uses these two weeks to finish preparing for our family camps. Projects include landscape cleanup, wood chipping, mowing, weed whipping, nature trail maintenance, planting and weeding flower beds, small equipment repairs, work order repairs, waterfront and marina care, and more.
- **Kitchen & Dish Room.** Many of our summer staff are cabin leaders for these two weeks which leave openings in our kitchen and dish room. With kitchen volunteers/staff, experience cooking and baking is helpful. With dish volunteers/staff, no experience is necessary you'll be an expert by the time you're done!

Little Eden Camp is excited to announce a new project happening at camp this spring which will include a webcam, security cameras, and the beginnings of expanded wifi.

Webcam. The webcam will be available on Little Eden's website, so when you're home, missing camp and wondering what it's like at Little Eden, you can just visit our website and enjoy the peaceful scenery from the back deck at camp overlooking the lake.

Security Cameras. In addition to the webcam, Little Eden will be installing security cameras overlooking the parking areas at the Lodge and at Pine Creek, the marina and waterfront, and the play-

ground area. Over the past ten years, we've had some security issues in the parking lots and in the marina – vehicles and boats being disturbed as well as items borrowed, missing or taken out of them. We also have had waterfront items moved and/or taken. And although camp is still a very safe place, we want to help stave off any future incidences.

Wifi. With this project, we will also be expanding the current wifi to include the areas around Balmy Heights and the playground. This will be in addition to the current areas in and around the lodge, in and around the craft hall, and in and around Pine Creek Lodge. This project will also enfold the wifi surrounding Pine Creek Lodge into our main wifi, eliminating a secondary, separate service, saving the camp funds on a monthly basis. It will also enable us to continue to expand wifi in future years to additional cabins and areas of camp.
